ABOUT

Oklahoma City University (OCU) is a private university with affiliations to the United Methodist Church representing the dedication to scholarship and service. OCU is well renowned and is the only university in Oklahoma listed in the top tier of the master level university category by US News and World Report magazine. OCU offers over 70 undergraduate majors as well as 17 graduate degree programs and doctorate programs in Law and Nursing. All classes are taught by professors and 80% of the faculty hold the highest degrees in their field. OCU has small class sizes allowing for students to receive personal attention and lots of interaction with the faculty. OCU has over 60 student organizations and clubs, an active fraternity and sorority system, and over 15 different intercollegiate athletic teams so there is no shortage of opportunities and things to do.

LOCATION

Oklahoma City University is located in the heart of the capital Oklahoma City. The city is the second largest in the US based on geographic size allowing for big city attractions while still allowing for easy accessibility and safety. Oklahoma City consistently ranks as one of the top cities to live in within the United States and was recently listed as #1 "Most Affordable US Cities" by Forbes magazine.
